Yalumba Distinguished Sites is a family of exceptional wines; each carefully sourced and masterfully crafted to capture the true essence of specific, special sites from which it is grown.



VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Eden Valley experienced below average rainfall during winter and the growing season which combined with a windy spring produced below average crops being set. Warm summer days developed intense flavours and cool nights have led to natural acidity being maintained, both of which are perfect for making a classic Riesling.

TERROIR/PROVENANCE/REGION

Owned and farmed by generations of the Grossman family, who have supplied grapes to Yalumba since 1926, this vineyard is in the heart of Eden Valley. The vineyard sits at an elevation of just over 400 metres, with a gentle north facing slope and gravely grey loam soil.

TASTING NOTES

A rich and elegant wine, with aromas of white flowers and lemon blossom. Flavours are reminiscent of preserved limes and dried herbs, with a refreshing lemon finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Enjoy with freshly shucked oysters, salt and pepper squid or sliced tomatoes and fresh basil drizzled with olive oil and a touch of balsamic vinegar.
